

Press Release**Arbitrator Grants Final Approval of Settlement with Genus Credit Management and InCharge Institute of America**

Green, granted final approval to a settlement with respondents Genus Credit Management and InCharge Institute of America in the arbitration styled *Jones et al. v. Genus Credit Management, Corp., et al.* The ruling comes following the hearing held on June 27, 2011 to consider final approval of the settlement. “We pleased that the Arbitrator agreed that the settlement was a fair compromise of claims made against Genus and InCharge and that the Class should be allowed to share in the financial benefits of the settlement,” said Joseph Tusa, co-counsel for the certified class. The settlement requires Genus Credit Management and InCharge Institute to pay \$4,000,000.00. This is the second settlement approved by the Arbitrator in this class arbitration, which is continuing against five respondents who have not settled with the Class.
