INVESTIGATION OF CALLS MADE TO CON EDISON CUSTOMERS' CELLULAR TELEPHONES

December 7, 2015.

Tusa P.C. is investigating calls made by Consolidated Edison (Con Ed or Con Edison) to its current or former utility customers' cell phones. We are also investigating calls made by debt collectors working for Con Ed to customers' cellular telephones.

Telephone calls or text messages made to consumers' cellular telephones without their consent may violate the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA). As reported in *Newsday*, Tusa P.C. has filed claims against utility companies for allegedly violating consumers' privacy rights protected by the TCPA.

Under the TPCA, it is unlawful to call a cellular telephone using an automatic telephone dialing system or an artificial or pre-recorded voice, unless the consumer has provided their prior express consent to do so.
