INVESTIGATION OF CELLULAR TELEPHONE CALLS MADE TO CUSTOMERS OF ORANGE & ROCKLAND UTILITIES, ROCKLAND COUNTY ELECTRIC AND PIKE COUNTY LIGHT AND POWER

December 7, 2015.

Tusa P.C. is investigating calls made by Orange & Rockland Utilities, Rockland County Electric and Pike County Light and Power to its current or former utility customers' cell phones. We are also investigating calls made by debt collectors working for Orange & Rockland Utilities, Rockland County Electric and Pike County Light and Power to customers' cellular telephones.

Telephone calls or text messages made to consumers' cellular telephones without their consent may violate the federal Telephone Consumer Protection Act (TCPA). As reported in *Newsday*, Tusa P.C. has filed claims against utility companies for allegedly violating consumers' privacy rights protected by the TCPA.

Under the TPCA, it is unlawful to call a cellular telephone using an automatic telephone dialing system or an artificial or pre-recorded voice, unless the consumer has provided their prior express consent to do so.
