

Press Release**Appeals Court Dismisses Appeal Challenging Class Action Settlement with Washington Mutual, Inc.**

Tusa P.C. is pleased to announce that yesterday the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit dismissed one of the objector appeals challenging the district court approval of the class action settlement with defendant Washington Mutual, Inc. Following the overwhelmingly positive class member reaction to the settlement with Washington Mutual, and final approval of the settlement by United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware and United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York, a handful of objectors appealed the final approval order. Those appeals are being opposed by counsel for the certified class, Tusa P.C. and Lowey Dannenberg Cohen and Hart, P.C. The appeal dismissed yesterday leaves three objector appeals in the federal appeals court.
